265,000 beneficiaries; 7,600 volunteers



**221 million** steps walked by employees to plant 15,000 fruit-bearing trees to economically empower farmers



**12 million** hot and nutritious mid-day meals distributed to 53,000 children studying in government schools



**125,000** people living in urban slums provided with access to primary healthcare



**65,000** fruit-bearing trees planted to augment the income of over 2,500 farmers and preserve local biodiversity



**35,000** people with limited access to electricity provided with power through solar units



**25,000** newspaper bags created by bank volunteers as a sustainable alternative to single-use plastic for communities



**5,850** persons with disabilities supported by providing skill development and assistive devices



**5,400** children with cancer received life-saving treatment, and psycho-emotional, nutritional and educational support



**1,500** women from vulnerable backgrounds supported with livelihood opportunities



**325** engineering scholarships provided to meritorious girls from low-income households



**150** volunteers shaved their heads to support the nutritional needs of child cancer patients



**8** members of the LGBTQIA+ community were trained to run a salon commissioned by the bank
